#### **REPLY ARGUMENT**

Under Issue Number 1, the state cites *Dobbins v. State*, 766 So. 2d 29, 32-33 (Miss. App, 2000) for the proposition that Cooper was not entitled to a heat of passion manslaughter instruction even though the alleged intended victim in this case admittedly was choking Cooper during an argument prior to the shooting and admitting firing a weapon at her also. [T. 68, 84, 117, 130-31, 149-52] The main distinctions, however, between *Dobbins* and the present case is that Dobbins expressed an intent to kill as the court noted, "it becomes eminently clear that Dobbins's earlier threat can be treated as evidence of malice". This preexisting homicidal animus is lacking here as to Mary Cooper. Plus Dobbins' lawyer did not request a heat of passion manslaughter instruction which was requested here. [T. 231-32; R. 155-56; R.E. 18-19] Therefore, *Dobbins* does not apply.

As to remaining points and other issues and arguments, the appellant rests on its initial brief and authorities therein.

#### **CONCLUSION**

Mary Cooper is entitled to have her conviction reversed and rendered, or to have

the case remanded for a new trial, or for resentencing for manslaughter.
