STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES

- 1. Did the Circuit Court err in dismissing Cause No. 09-CV-056?
- 2. Did the Circuit Court err in dismissing Cause No. 09-CV-056 in belief that proper notice had not been given to the Defendant, Azhar Pasha, M.D.?

STATEMENT OF THE FACTS

In March 2009, the Plaintiff, Harrison Lewis, Jr. prior to entering a scheduled Hearing ordered by the Social Security Administration office located at the Social Security building at 4817 North Park Drive—Meridian, MS 39305, discovered medical malpractice admissions by the Defendant, Dr. Azhar Pasha, M.D., via medical records given to the Plaintiff, Harrison Lewis, Jr., to view by Social Security officials, prior to the Hearing. The Defendant, Azhar Pasha, M.D., was served proper notice of the lawsuit on May 26, 2009.

ARGUMENT

THE CIRCUIT COURT ERRED IN DISMISSING CAUSE NO. 09 -CV-056

The Plaintiff, Harrison Lewis, Jr. was not made aware of the damaging nature of the medical malpractice diagnosis until March 2009 at the scheduled Hearing ordered by the Social Security Administration. Federal and State law permits the tolling of the Statute of Limitations in the case of medical malpractice, i.e., Statute of Limitations does not begin until the discovery of an injury.

<u>CONCLUSION</u>

For the foregoing reasons, the decision of the Circuit Court should be reversed.
